This meeting of the Financial Advisory Roundtable (FAR) will feature a retrospective of topics about financial stability. How have FAR members' experiences during the past ten years shaped what they see as the key financial stability issues in the next years to come? How have members' views of important factors affecting financial stability changed over time? How have FAR meeting discussions affected the members' views on these issues and on the appropriate policy responses?

Potential topics include:

- Tradeoffs between financial stability and market liquidity
- Liquidity risk management and the risk of runs
- "Excess" demand for risk-free assets
- Financial instability and asset management, hedge funds, and other investment vehicles
- Capital requirements for financial intermediaries
- Whether "too big to fail" has been satisfactorily addressed
- Lender of last resort in the Dodd-Frank era
- Accounting and valuation
- Propagation of financial crises into the real economy
