- To what extent are businesses facing ongoing supply pressures? If so, when do you expect these pressures to abate?
- Are businesses raising wages to attract workers and fill open positions? Are the groups you
 work with or community you represent seeing higher wages? Has the economic recovery
 affected the ability of workers to bargain for wages or benefits?
- How are businesses and households/communities responding to the higher prices of some items, such as gasoline and groceries? How have changes in inflation since the start of the pandemic affected decisions to spend or invest?
- Do you see areas where the economic recovery has been uneven? What risks do these disparities pose for our economic performance?
- How are renters and homeowners faring with regard to their rent and mortgage payments?
- How has the pandemic changed how and where people live and work? What changes are likely to be permanent? Is working together in the office and in multistory office buildings a thing of the past?
- In what ways will individuals and businesses need to adjust to the new normal?
- How do you assess the level of confidence in the business or community you represent? How has this level of confidence changed since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic?
