Election of Directors

(By member banks classified in Group 3 on September 26, 2005, that is, member banks with capital and surplus of less than \$30 million on that date)

To the Member Banks of the Second Federal Reserve District:

In accordance with section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act, as amended, and Circular No. 11734, dated September 26, 2005, on the nomination of directors of this Bank for terms of office ending December 31, 2008, to succeed Charles V. Wait, class A director, and Marta Tienda, class B director, whose terms expire December 31, 2005, there are shown on the following pages the names of the candidates nominated for such offices, and by whom nominated.

To each member bank classified in Group 3 on September 26, 2005, the following are being sent with this circular:

- (a) Ballot for use in voting for a class A and a class B director.
- (b) Pink ballot envelope in which the ballot is to be sealed.
- (c) Certificate envelope bearing on its face the certificate in regard to the vote.
- (d) Addressed envelope in which all of the foregoing should be returned to this Bank.

The ballot and the certificate on the certificate envelope must be executed by an officer who has been authorized to cast the vote. A list of the officers designated for this purpose by the member banks in Group 3 was contained in the above-mentioned circular dated September 26, 2005; the list is also contained herein. In order that the ballots may be secret, the name of the bank and the name and title of the voting officer should not be written on the ballot, but should be written only on the certificate envelope.

- (1) The ballot should be marked.
- (2) The marked ballot should be placed in the pink ballot envelope and that envelope sealed.
- (3) Then the sealed pink ballot envelope should be placed within the certificate envelope, and the certificate envelope should be sealed and the certificate thereon executed.
- (4) Then the certificate envelope containing the sealed pink ballot envelope should be returned to this Bank in the enclosed addressed envelope.

The law provides that the ballot shall be cast within 15 days after receipt of the list of candidates transmitted herewith. The polls will open at 10 a.m., November 3, 2005, and will close at 12 noon on Friday, November 18, 2005, and in order to be counted as valid the ballot must be received at or before the latter time. Upon the closing of the polls the ballot box will be opened, the votes counted and checked by tellers, and the results of the election announced. The candidates may, if they so desire, be present or represented on this occasion.

Because banks in Groups 1 and 2 will not vote in this election, this circular is sent to them without forms and for their information only.

His awards include the Commitment to Community Award from the New York State Business Council, Outstanding New Yorker from the New York State Jaycees, a Private Sector Initiative Award from President Ronald Reagan, the Capital District Business Review Executive of the Year in 1999, and an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters from SUNY Empire State College in 2001. In 2003, Mr. Wait received the Denis B. Kemball-Cook Award and the Lucy Skidmore Scribner Award, both from Skidmore College.

Mr. Wait resides in Saratoga Springs with his wife, Candace and their three children.

Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer General Electric Company Fairfield, Connecticut

JEFFREY R. IMMELT, 49, is Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of GE. Mr. Immelt, the 9th Chairman in GE's 126-year history, was appointed to this post on September 7, 2001. Previously, Mr. Immelt served as President and Chairman-elect of GE from November 2000, when GE's Board of Directors selected him to succeed John F. Welch. From 1997 to 2000, Mr. Immelt had been President and CEO of GE Medical Systems, which is today a \$12 billion leader in the healthcare industry.

He began his GE career in 1982. Over the last 23 years, Mr. Immelt has held a series of global leadership roles in GE's Plastics, Appliance, and Medical businesses. He became an Officer of GE in 1989, and joined the GE Capital Board in 1997.

He serves on the board of two non-profit organizations: Catalyst, devoted to advancing women in business; and Robin Hood, focused on addressing poverty in New York City. Mr. Immelt was named the Financial Times "Man of the Year" for 2003.

Mr. Immelt holds a B.A. degree in applied mathematics from Dartmouth College (1978) and an M.B.A. from Harvard University (1982). He and his wife, Andrea, have one daughter.
