



Figure 2: Coronavirus Spread in the Region


Daily New Cases Per Capita, 7-Day Average

Figure 3: Local Businesses Still Struggling


New York Fed Regional Business Surveys, Current Conditions

Figure 4: Employment Below Pre-Pandemic Levels


Percent Change in Total Employment Since February 2020

Figure 5: Consumer Spending Has Flattened


Percent Change in Debit & Credit Card Spending Since Feb 2020

Figure 6: Home Prices Have Increased


Percent Change in Home Prices, Indexed to January 2015
