Forum on FX-related Dodd-Frank Reforms for the Buy-Side

The meeting began with a discussion of the agenda for the April 26 Forum on the Dodd-Frank Act and the Foreign Exchange Market being put on by the Foreign Exchange Committee.

Dodd-Frank Operational/Implementation Issues

The group discussed its progress on addressing a variety of Dodd-Frank operational and implementation issues including FX trade reporting, pre-trade mid, confirmation strawman, swap trading relationship documentation, and the CFTC's external business conduct rules and electronic executions.

EMTA Discontinuation of Fixing Surveys

The group briefly discussed EMTA's decision to discontinue its fixing surveys and possible replacements.

CLS: Currency Splitting

The group revisited the issue of the CLS system's split of large value instructions into smaller ones that was raised during the March meeting. Members of the group generally concurred that the ISDA Master Agreement gives sufficient protection in such instances.

Quadrilateral

The group briefly discussed the Quadrilateral scheduled for July. Members of the group were asked to volunteer to speak on particular topics.

Legal Opinion Update Project

The group paid tribute to David Miller for his many years of service on the FMLG and congratulated him on his retirement.
